- I. Other Business
  - a. Meal per diem and GSA lodging rates

Paul shared that changes were made to the State of Illinois statutes for meal per diem and lodging limitations. The governor signed House bill 4285 on Monday January 23, 2023, which increased meal per diems for state employees and allowed higher ed institutions to follow the lodging rates established by the General Services Administration (GSA). Since the new lodging rates only apply to higher ed, the JCAR Regulations must be updated before HETCB institutions can apply them.

Paul asked if board members wanted to hold a special meeting to accept the new lodging rates. Kent asked if a special meeting was needed. Paul advised that a board member could make a motion to approve the new rates. Kent made a motion to approve the GSA lodging allowances as stated in House bill 4285. Tracy Rembusch seconded. All in favor. None opposed. Motion carried.

Paul asked if anyone had anything else to discuss and received no response.

Paul advised the next meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, April 26, 2023, and asked for a motion to adjourn the meeting. Motion made by Carla and seconded by Kent.
